



Mt. Fuji Hike pre info pack

Our dates	We offer 3 Fuji hikes in 2024: Sat 6th / Sun 7th of July 2024 Sat 24th / Sun 25th of August 2024 Sat 7th / Sun 8th of September 2024
Our trail	There are 4 trails to the top of Mt. Fuji. The most popular one is the Yoshida route, around 60% people use this trail because of easy access from Tokyo and lots of huts on the way. We are hiking the Subashiri-route, which is used only about 10% of the climbers to escape from the crowds. Also, as this route face to east, we can expect the sunrise from anywhere. Our itinerary	<p>Saturday, day 1 arrival from Tokyo (not included)</p> <p>9:00 dep - 9:30 arr. Change to the shuttle bus for Subashiri 5th Station</p> <p>9:30am meet at Subahiri-guchi 5th station, 1-2hours here to adjust high altitude. Early lunch in the restaurant.</p> <p>11:30am start climbing Subashiri route. (1970m-3140m, 5-6hrs)</p> <p>4:00pm-5:00pm arrive at mountain hut, curry dinner, sleep.</p> <p>Sunday, day 2 4:00am-5:00am</p>

	<p>Sunrise view from the hut and breakfast (*or departure at 1:00am to see the sunrise from the top, depends on the group)</p> <p>6:00 am: Leave hut</p> <p>9:00 am: Get to the top - 8 peaks / crater loop walk available if weather permits</p> <p>11:00 am: Begin descending to Subashiri 5th station.</p> <p>2:00-3:00 pm: Arrive at Subashiri trail head. Lunch. End of guidance.</p>
Your equipment	<p>As soon as you signed up, you will receive a list with all equipment needed.</p> <p>It's also possible to rent equipment. Please check out this website: (https://www.yamarent.com/en/item.html?language=en)</p>
Extra money	<p>What to expect on Mt Fuji:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You can buy a stick/pole on the 5th station and collect stamps on each station we pass during our climb. Each stamp is around ¥300-¥500 • Water - from ¥200 to ¥300 • Donation (entrance is ¥1000). • Toilets from ¥200, ¥300 and there is one toilet that is ¥500, Prepare coins.
Optional	<p>To avoid any stress on Saturday morning (traffic etc.) you have the possibility to go Gotemba the day before and enjoy the evening in the outlets or at an amazing onsen.</p> <p>From our recommended hotel, it's only a 1hr bus ride to our meeting point.</p>
